#### THE SCHOOL YEAR

The school year 2019/ 2020 started very well in September 2019. The first term ended in December and new students who joined the school in Form 1 were selected on to the bursary.

Fees for the school terms was paid when; examination fees was also paid for form 4 students.

Open Hearts Germany had recommended that the students undergo extra lessons in order to enhance class performance of the students; fees for this activity was paid in the second term.

On 21<sup>st</sup> March 2020, it was declared that all public institutions should be closed due to the Corona Virus pandemic. All schools in the country were closed and this also affected the planned remedial classes which failed to start.

School reports which were at the time being compiled were also not submitted.

## **POST COVID 19 PANDEMIC**

The government recommended the reopening of schools in September, having assessed the infection rate, hence schools opened on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2020 for the third term.

As may be seen, the second term was not fully completed and students did not even sit for end of term examinations. As a result, there are no school reports for the first and second term.

Malawi School Certificate of Examinations was cancelled after it was discovered that there of leakage of the examination papers and this made form 4 students fail to write their final examinations. The government has rescheduled the examinations to January 2020.

The third term which started on 29<sup>th</sup> September will end on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2020.

The school calendar for the yar 2021 is as follows:

First Term: 4<sup>th</sup> January to 26<sup>th</sup> March. Second Term: 12<sup>th</sup> April to 21<sup>st</sup> July. Third Term: 19<sup>th</sup> July to 8<sup>th</sup> October

#### **CHALLENGES**

- 1. The school year has gaps, the 6 months break due to the Corona virus pandemic resulted in school work for 2 terms being squeezed in one school term.
- Change in the time for writing the final examination which has demotivated the candidates and made them to stay longer in their final year.
- 3. A lot of negative issues have happened during the 6 months the students were at home due to COVID 19. Early marriages and teenage pregnancies have been on the rise which has resulted in an increase in dropout rate. Some children have fallen victims of alcohol and substance abuse which has resulted in some of them dropping out of school and others becoming criminals.
- 4. Student dropout from school was very high in the year, for classes in form 1 to form 3, replacements were made. However Form 4 students who dropped out of school were not replaced.

Tsogolo la Ana organisation sincerely appreciates the assistance received from Open Hearts Germany; without this, many children would not have attained secondary school in this country.
