

REVISED PROPOSAL FOR A GIRLS EDUCATION

TARGET GROUP: 17 girls who are under TAO education bursary.

PROJECT GOAL: To encourage girls to work hard in school and prevent themselves from early marriages/pregnancy.

ISSUE

- High dropout rate among female students who are under TAO education bursary due to early pregnancy and early marriages.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

1. To reduce dropout rate among girls who are under TAO education bursary.
2. To promote non risk taking behavior among the girls addressing knowledge, behavior change, attitude, beliefs and practices to reduce HIV and AIDS transmission and sexual practices.

OUTPUTS

1. Reduced dropout rate among girls in secondary school.
2. Behavior change of the community and among girls on H.I.V and AIDS and education of girls.

REVISED ACTIVITIES

1. Conduct a workshop once per term with parents and guardians of 17 girls who are under TAO education bursary on the importance of education and include 1 member from NAMASO Community Based organization, 1 member from Education office.
2. Conduct a one day workshop with girls once per term to encourage them to work hard in school.
3. Organize a camp for 17 girls to promote them on the importance of educating for 3 days once per academic year.
4. Provide awards to girls who perform well in class to motivate them.
5. Provide individual and group counseling therapy to 17 girls who are under TAO bursary.
6. Produce a training manual for the girls.

IMPACT

1. A reduction in the incidences of dropout rate in school due to early pregnancies and early marriages among the girls who are under TAO education bursary.
2. Change of behavior, attitude, beliefs and practices on issues relating to the importance of educating among girls and their parents and guardians who are under TAO education bursary.

Training manual

This will be necessary because of the following reasons:

1. The manual will be there forever guiding the facilitators on the necessary material to deliver to the girls.
2. The manual will bring in consistence.
3. Preparation for the workshop/training will be easy and focused.

The manual will be reviewed every year responding to the new issues which may arise. Any matters which will be arising in the implementation period will be taken note of and be included in the manual.

Contents of the Training manual

1. Importance of education.
2. Factors which affects the education of a girl child.
3. The role of parents/guardians to the education of a girl child.
4. Role of a child to her education.
5. Life skills: Decision making, assertiveness, H.I.V and AIDS, counseling etc
6. Spiritual development.
7. Career guidance.
8. Home craft.
